



## Albuquerque Rebels Volleyball Club (ARVC) 2012 Volleyball Club Season – Player/Parent Policy and Financial Contract

The following contract will apply to all Albuquerque Rebels Volleyball Club (ARVC) players and their parent(s). Participating in this year's volleyball season, players and parent(s) must read and sign this contract before taking part in any ARVC activities.

We agree to accept or decline an offered position via the ARVC website, [www.arvcrebels.com](http://www.arvcrebels.com), within 72 hours of receiving an offer.

We understand that by accepting a position and signing this contract players and their parent(s) hereby commit to the following:

1. Player agrees that she will play for the duration of the season and parent(s) agree they shall pay the team's monthly dues for the duration of the season. Failure to adhere to this agreement may jeopardize a player's ability to participate on an ARVC team.
2. Parent(s) must agree that they will conduct themselves at all times in accordance with USA Volleyball, Sun Country Regional Volleyball, and ARVC rules and policies. They shall not engage in arguments or other unsportsmanlike conduct with coaching staff, officials, other players, or spectators.
3. Player agrees that she will display good sportsmanship at all times and conduct herself properly at tournaments, practices, and team meetings, both on and off the court.
4. Player agrees that she will attend all scheduled practices in order to work on her own playing skills and her team's improvement. Repeated failure to attend or consistent tardiness to these scheduled practices may result in reduced or no playing time in tournaments at the coaches' discretion.
  - a. Player will receive an equal amount of coaching attention at practices and tournaments. Player's attitude, hard work, and self-determination will produce positive result during competitions. **Playing time is earned.**
5. Parent(s) acknowledge that ARVC depends upon full payment of all fees to meet its financial obligations. Parent(s) agree that they will promptly meet their financial obligations to ARVC and their team. Player and parent(s) acknowledge that if the player's dues or fees are delinquent the player **will not** be able to participate in subsequent tournaments or practices.

- a. To accept a position on this club team, the family enters into a financial contract with ARVC. There are two payment options: 1) Payment in Full (Due at 5pm on Nov. 30, 2011) in which a 10% discount applies; or 2) Installment Plan in which fees will be paid from November 2011 through April 2012 according to the following schedule:

Initial Fee	November 30, 2011 5pm
1st	December 15, 2011 5pm
2nd	January 15, 2012 5pm
3rd	February 15, 2012 5pm
4th	March 15, 2012 5pm
5th	April 1, 2012 5pm (*Note-this is the 1st of the month)

- b. Any late payments will result in a player being ineligible to practice or participate in tournaments until the player's account is current.
- c. Any late payments will be assessed a \$30 late fee. An additional \$30 late fee will be assessed for each additional 30 days delinquent. A \$30 fee will be assessed for each returned check.
- d. If a financial hardship occurs, please contact the club director immediately to discuss and resolve the issue in a timely manner.
- e. Any player who has an outstanding balance at the end of 2011 volleyball club season will be ineligible to participate with ARVC or other clubs until the debt is satisfied. Also, if a prospective or returning player has an outstanding debt with another club in the Sun Country region, no tryout or play will be allowed until all financial obligations have been fulfilled.
- f. If any unpaid balances continue to remain delinquent, ARVC reserves the right to pursue collection or legal action to collect any unpaid balances. ARVC will seek all delinquent amounts as well as court costs and attorney fees.
- g. If you are removed from your team and/or club for a violation of the club rules, contract indebtedness, or any violations of the law, you will be responsible for the full amount of your financial obligation to ARVC.
6. Player agrees that she will abide by all USA Volleyball, Sun Country Regional Volleyball, and ARVC rules and policy; and parent(s) agree that they will require such compliance.
7. Player agrees that she will participate fully in all fund raising activities, as determined by their team.
8. Player agrees that she will care for all ARVC equipment, practice facilities, uniform, and tournament sites.

9. Parent(s) and player agree that their name, age, position(s), height, team, high school, expected graduation date, and photograph can be posted onto the ARVC website.
10. Player and parent(s) agree to display traits such as teamwork, cooperation, and self-discipline to the coaches. Player and parent(s) also acknowledge the coaches' instructions and leave the coaching to the coaches.
11. Players and parents acknowledge that they have received and reviewed (or reviewed online) the current ARVC handbook. They agree to adhere to all ARVC policies.
12. ARVC reserves the right to amend policies as it sees fit to accommodate unforeseen changes.

We have read the above and agree in full with the policies as set forth. We understand that we are responsible for full payment of the player's account. We understand, agree, and acknowledge that there is an inherent risk in sports participation and/or, physical activity and/or strenuous exercises and/or competition. We hereby forever waive and release ARVC, its club director, coaching staff, and assignees from any and all liability stemming from any injuries and/or illnesses incurred while participating in ARVC volleyball activities.
